Target Audience

Course Overview

This course provides the basic knowledge and skills required to undertake the local operation of high voltage circuit breaking devices and to perform switching to a switching program. It included interactive presentations, oral delivery and written assessments in a training room environment followed by practical exercises of switching indoor and outdoor type high voltage switchgear. It also provides an introduction and limited training in the preparation of high voltage switching sheets and access permits for basic, non-complex high voltage switching programs.

- Statutory compliance (Acts & Regs, Codes of practice etc)
- Basic high voltage switching principles
- Site specific high voltage switching procedures
- Operation of indoor and outdoor type switchgear
- Prepare non-complex switching sheets and permits
