COURSE OVERVIEW

This course is intended for non-electrical personnel required to work closely and in conjunction with electrical tradespersons in coal mining

Training for these competencies involves both classroom theory and practical training components presented by **qualified electrical personnel** for trade qualified or assisting trade qualified persons.

COURSE CONTENT

This course covers planning and preparing for support; supporting the tradesperson; and applying emergency procedures, the performance of rescue procedures from live Low Voltage (LV) apparatus, not including overhead lines and underground cables in the work place. It specifies the mandatory requirements of rescue from a live LV panel and how they apply in the context of transmission, distribution or rail work functions. It encompasses responsibilities for, health, safety and risk management processes at all operative levels and adherence to safety practices as part of the normal way of doing work.
